Pursuing Persian Promotions

Act 1: The King pursues a new Queen (2:1-4)

Scene 1: The King Reflects (2:1)

- Xerxes remembered...
 - ✦ Vashti (v. 1a)
 - What Vashti had done (v. 1b)
 - What had been decreed against her (v. 1c)
 - Vashti was kicked out...permanently.
- Did he love her? Probably not.
 - ✦ Her replacement was meant to satisfy his <u>sexual</u> desires.
 - His request for Vashti at the party showed what he really <u>valued</u> about her.

Scene 2: Xerxes' Change of Focus: Getting a <u>Better</u> Queen! (2:2-4)

- These young men feared <u>retaliation</u> of Xerxes or possibly Vashti.
- They initiated this <u>alternative</u>: "Let beautiful young virgins be sought out for the king" (v. 2).
- "What a liability to be <u>beautiful</u>"—Baldwin



Act 2: Jews Pursuing Persian Positions

Scene 1: Introductions of these Jews (2:5-7)

- ✦ Mordecai
 - Similar to the Babylonian name Mardukaya
 - It means <u>warrior</u>.
 - His father was captured by Babylon.
- Esther
 - Hebrew name- Hadassah- <u>myrtle</u>
 - "Esther" means star
 - This name comes from the pagan goddess "Ishtar," who was the goddess of <u>love</u> and <u>war</u>.
 - She was lovely to look at (2:7; see also 1:11)
- This is a disappointing introduction:
 - Why are these Jews still in Susa?
 - ♦ Why do they keep using their <u>Pagan names</u>?
 - Why are they pursuing Persian promotions?

Scene 2:

Esther's Entrance into the Contest (2:8-11)

Moral Dilemma: Was Esther taken, or did she volunteer?

- ◆ Esther was _____ (2:8b)
- ◆ Same word as when _____ took her (2:7).
- 2 words which display both Esther's sin and God's sovereignty:
 - ✦ Pleased
 - ✦ Favor
- Esther was given...
 - ✦ Cosmetics



- ✦ Food
- ✤ 7 young women
- ✦ Best <u>place</u> in the harem

Mordecai's advice: Don't tell them that you are a <u>Jew</u>!

Why did Mordecai advise her this way? Here are 3 possibilities:

- ✦ Anti-Israel sentiments
- ✦ Restrictions on who the King could marry
- ◆ <u>Political</u> advancement

How Esther advanced:

- ✦ She won <u>favor</u>.
- ✦ She used her pagan <u>name</u>.
- ✦ She ate the pagan food.
- ✦ She concealed her <u>nationality</u>.

Contest Regulations:

- ♦ Preparation for 12 months
 - 6 months of myrrh (v. 12a)
 - 6 months of spices and ointments (v. 12b)
- Process
 - She could bring whatever she wanted with her from the harem (v. 13)
 - She would have one <u>night</u> with the king.
 - After that night, she would go to the second harem.

Contest Results: Esther won!

- ✦ The King responded immediately.
- ✦ She received the royal crown.



Scene 3: Mordecai Kills the Murder Plot (2:19-23)

- Mordecai received this knowledge of the murder plot at the king's <u>gate</u> (v. 21)
- + He told Esther, who told King Xerxes "in the name of Mordecai" (v. 22).

God placed Mordecai in the right place at the right time.

God's Sovereignty in the Shadows

- ✦ Esther's Persian name- goddess of love and war
- ✦ Esther's <u>name</u>
- The words <u>pleased</u> and favor
- ✦ A perfect replacement for Vashti
- + Hiding her nationality (even if it was wrong to do)
- ✤ Mordecai sitting in the king's gate at the right time

Practical Applications

- Do you blend in with the world, or do you stand out for God? (Matt. 5:14-16, Rom. 12:1-2, 1 John 2:15-17)
- + Are you willing to make compromises in order to get what you want?
- Do you see people as people or as <u>objects</u>? No person can ever fulfill all of your needs like <u>Jesus</u> can!
- ✦ God still works in our lives despite our sin.
