Esther 5:9-6:14

"Pride goes before destruction, and a haughty spirit before a fall." Proverbs 16:18

Act 1: Haman's Pride (5:9-14)

Scene 1 Haman's Temporary Happiness

Esther 5:9-10

- Haman was <u>happy</u> (v. 9a)
- Haman was not happy. (v. 9b)

Scene 2

Haman's Bragging Session

Esther 5:11-14

- Possessions- The splendor of his riches...
- Posterity- The number of his sons...
- <u>Positions</u>- all the promotions which the king had honored him
- <u>Power</u>- how we had advanced him above the officials and the servants of the king
- Haman bragged and <u>complained</u>.
 - + He wanted Mordecai dead.
 - Zeresh gave Haman an <u>idea</u>.- Let a gallows fifty cubits high be made...

Act 2: Xerxes' Nation-Saving Nightmare

Scene 1 The Sleepless Night Esther 6:1-3

- Xerxes could not sleep, which literally means, the king's sleep <u>fled</u>.
- Xerxes' solution to sleeplessness- The Persian Chronicles



- The Story- Mordecai stopped an assassination plot!
- The Shock- I haven't honored him!

Scene 2 The Surprising Morning Esther 6:4-9

- Xerxes and Haman were both thinking about Mordecai.
- Haman's Idea:
 - ✦ The King's <u>Robes</u>- Let the royal robes be brought...
 - ◆ The King's <u>Horse</u>- And the royal horse the king has ridden...
 - ✦ The King's Official- One of the king's most noble officials...
 - ◆ The King's <u>Message</u>- "Thus shall it be done to the man..."

Scene 3 Mordecai's Parade Esther 6:10-14

- Pre-parade- Irony- Do so to Mordecai
- During the Parade- Haman left <u>nothing</u> out.
- Post-Parade- Mordecai returned to the gate while Haman mourned.
 - ✦ Haman was beginning to <u>fall</u>.
 - Haman was summoned to Esther's 2nd feast...

God's Sovereignty in the Shadows

- Haman's ignorance of Esther and Mordecai's relationship
- Xerxes' <u>sleeplessness</u>
- The specific reading of the Persian Chronicles
- Haman's horrible counselors
- Haman's Ironic Timing

- Pride brings destruction!
- God can create a way even when there is absolutely no way.
