Disciplers of Christ know their Role (vs. 19-28).

- They reject undue praise (vs. 19-22).
- They humbly acknowledge their roles (vs. 23-24).
- They recognize true greatness (vs. 25-27).

Disciplers of Christ promote their Savior (v. 29-38).

- Promote Him with word (vs. 29-34, 36).
- Promote Him with sacrifice (vs. 35-38).

Disciplers of Christ pursue people (v. 39-51).

- Pursue people through invitation.
- Pursue people through partnership.
