A Proper Perspective on Riches.

- Riches have limitations.
 - Wealth disappears quickly (Proverbs 10:2; 23:4-5)
 - Riches don't necessary measure success accurately (Proverbs 13:7).
 - Doesn't matter in critical moments (Proverbs 11:4).
 - Wealth can bring blessings or troubles (Proverbs 15:6).
 - At the same time, don't trust in riches (Proverbs 11:28).
 - Wealth builds shallow friendships (Proverbs 19:4)
- Riches have benefits.
 - Wealth does give some level of protection (Proverbs 10:15; 18:11).
 - Independence and freedom (Proverbs 22:7).
 - Some good friendships (Proverbs 19:4; 14:20).
- Riches have an impact on people.
 - Riches turn you away from God (Proverbs 30:7-9).
 - Riches produce false security (Proverbs 18:11; 28:11).
 - Riches can lead to mistreating others (Proverbs 18:23).
 - Borrowers are indebted (Proverbs 22:7).
- Riches are overrated.
 - A good name is better (Proverbs 22:1).
 - Wisdom is better (Proverbs 8:18-21).
 - Loving fellowship is better (Proverbs 15:17).
 - Humility is better (Proverbs 16:19).
 - Righteousness is better (Proverbs 16:8).
 - The fear of the Lord is better (Proverbs 15:16).
 - A virtuous woman is better (Proverbs 19:14; 31:1-9).
- Riches from God are a blessing (Proverbs 10:22; James 1:17).

- How to Get Money
 - Foolish ways to get money:
 - Through Dishonestly (Proverbs 28:8)
 - Through “Get-Rich Quick” Schemes (Proverbs 20:21; 21:5b; 28:20a, 22)
 - Through vanity (Proverbs 13:11a)
 - Through lying (Proverbs 21:6)
 - Wise ways to get money:
 - Through Diligence (Proverbs 10:4; 12:27b; 21:5a)
 - Through an Inheritance (Proverbs 13:22; 19:14; 20:21)
 - Through Wisdom and Knowledge (Proverbs 14:24; 24:3-4).
 - Through Faithfulness (Proverbs 28:20b)
 - Through hard work (Proverbs 11:25; 13:11b).
 - Through avenues of God's blessing (Proverbs 10:22; James 1:17)
- How to Use Money
 - Keep close watch over your wealth (Proverbs 27:23-27).
 - Give offerings to the Lord (Proverbs 3:9-10).
 - Exercise patience, not impulsive spending (Proverbs 21:20).
 - Be generous to those less-fortunate (Proverbs 22:16).
 - Save it for the future (Proverbs 13:22; 19:14; 20:21).
