Keep These Things Fresh (Titus 3:1-11)

Remember how to live in the world (vs. 1-2).

- Respond correctly to your authorities:
 - In submission
 - In obedience
 - In helpfulness
- Realize how to live in society.
 - Without slander
 - Without fighting
 - With kindness
 - With humility

Remember your spiritual journey (vs. 3-7).

- Remember how bad it was.
 - You were ignorant.
 - You were enslaved
 - You were destructive.
- Remember how things changed.
 - What started it: Jesus' miraculous appearance.
 - What happened: You were saved.
 - How it happened: The Spirit of God.
 - Why it happened:



- To justify you.
- To make you an heir.

Remember your message (v. 8).

- Your message is reliable.
- Your message is repeatable.
- Your message is practical.
- Your message is beneficial.

Remember to avoid false teachers (v. 9).

- By avoiding their worthless messages.
 - Their messages question truth.
 - Their messages indulge pride.
 - Their messages bring conflict.
 - Their messages flaunt disagreements.
- By engaging them carefully.
 - Step 1: Warn them
 - Step 2: Warn them again
 - Step 3: Reject them
- By realizing why rejection is necessary.
 - Their minds are twisted.
 - Their hearts are hardened.
 - Their consciences are guilty.
