- Through relational connections.
- Through real-life, strategic circumstances.

Missional Partners are Purposefully Supportive (v. 13).

- Support with an excited spirit.
- Support with willing sacrifice.
- Support with effective results.

Missional Partners “Pick It Up” as they Participate (v. 14).

- Partners “pick it up” through giving it up.
- Partners “pick it up” through trying it themselves.
- Partners “picking it up” brings personal growth.

Missional Partners Preserve their Partnerships (v. 15).

- Partnerships are preserved through communication.
- Partnerships are preserved through loyalty.
- Partnerships are preserved through doctrine.
